

## Installing Zenith u-he Repro-1 MIDI Map

Due to u-he plugins not having an import MIDI map option, you will have to replace the default MIDI map.

1. Go to the data folder of Repro-1.

By default, (unless installed elsewhere) on MacOS this folder should be in “~/Library/Application Support/u-he/Repro-1/Support” and on Windows in “C:\Users\username\Documents\u-he\Repro-1\Support”.

If you don't know where this folder is located you can launch Repro-1 and click on the presets button on the top right corner, then right click a preset to select “open in explorer/reveal in finder”.



This will point to the “presets” folder which is in the “u-he\Repro-1\Presets\Repro-1” folder. Navigate to “u-he\Repro-1\Support” folder by going up three folders.

2. Copy and paste the “com.u-he.Repro-1.midiassign.txt” file that's provided within the “MIDI Maps/u-he Repro-1 MIDI Map” folder in the Zenith archive to the “Support” folder of Repro-1.
